7. The date of Examination(s), Centre of Examination will be indicated in the Admit Card.

8. Applicants in Government service other than casual or muster roll will be required to State in the application form that they have informed in writing to their employer/controlling authority that they are applying for the examination. In case the employer or the controlling authority withholds permission to the candidate for appearing in the examination, such applications will be rejected.

9. Candidates must carry at least one photo bearing IDENTITY PROOF in original such as Driving Licence, Voter ID Card, Aadhaar Card, Identity Card issued by University/College, Income Tax PAN Card to the examination centre, failing which THEY SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO APPEAR IN THE EXAMINATION.

10. All types of electronic gadgets including mobile phones, pagers etc. are not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. Any infringement of these instructions shall entail disciplinary action including ban from future examinations.
