SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Competitive Departmental Examination consisting of 3 papers - 3 hours duration each

(i) Paper - I: One paper of 100 marks for a duration of 3 hours to test the General Knowledge, Aptitude, Intelligence, Test of Comprehension and Expression of Law and General English including Essay Writing on Legal Topic and Information Technology.

The competitive examination shall be conducted with the syllabus as given below:-

- (ii) Paper-II: One paper of 100 marks for a duration of 3 hours regarding objective questions and problems of law as regards the Transfer of Property Act, Civil Procedure Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act, Indian Penal Code, Limitation Act.

All candidates who obtain sixty percent or more marks or corresponding grade in the written examination shall be eligible for viva voce examination.

Provided that Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates who obtain fifty percent or more marks or corresponding grade in the written examination shall be eligible for the viva voce examination.

Selection of candidates shall be made on the basis of cumulative grade value obtained, in the written and viva voce examination.

The object of the viva-voce examination under sub-rule (1) and (2) is to assess the suitability of the candidate for the cadre by judging the mental alertness, knowledge of law, clear and logical exposition, balance of judgment, skills, attitude, ethics, power of assimilation, power of communication, character and intellectual depth and the like of the candidate.

All necessary steps not provided under these Rules for recruitment shall be decided by the recruiting authority.
